Frequently asked questions with answers!

- 1. This is a two-week program in July! Can my child take only one week?**
 - A. Yes! However, your child will not be in all the numbers scheduled for his/her section. Morning session is for students in Grades 3 ~ 7 ~ Ten AM ~ Noon ~ Afternoon session is for students in Grades 8 ~ 12 One PM ~ 3:00 pm. We will be teaching ALL students the opening and closing songs. The AM sessions will learn 4 additional songs and dances and the PM sessions will learn 4 different songs & dances. If your child only arrives for one week of classes to either section they may not be able to learn all 6 numbers. You also must pay for your child's t-shirt, as it's included when you pay for both weeks! But we will do our best, as no child should feel badly if they have other plans and cannot make the two weeks. This is an incredible opportunity. We will be doing this each summer! Mark your calendars NOW! Same two weeks each year!

- 2. How much is the course?**

- 8. What if we have to take a day or two off for vacation?**
A. It happens however; remember it's a two-week course with Broadway dancers and singers. You will want your child to experience 100% of what the teachers have to offer!
- 9. Where will the rehearsals and show be held?**
A. As of April 9, 2008 we do not have a site for the show on July 18th however; we are working on a great space! We may rehearse at the Children's Corner studio next to the Fours in Quincy Center. We will let all participants know in a timely manner.
- 10. Is there a dress rehearsal?**
A. Yes! All day July 18th with ALL students at the site of the show. TBA!
- 11. Is there a charge for tickets to the show and can anyone attend?**
